

THE FEAST OF THE **DIVINE MERCY** is the first Sunday following

Easter Sunday. In St. Faustina's diary, Jesus explains how to obtain the unique graces on Divine Mercy Sunday: "The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete

forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day, all the Divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though his sins be as scarlet....Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the fount of My Mercy." (Diary, 699)

What makes the Divine Mercy Sunday graces so unique? To obtain a plenary indulgence throughout the year, the individual must be detached from all sin, which is very difficult. However, Jesus does not require complete detachment from sin with the special graces he offers on Divine Mercy. This is the only time complete detachment from sin is not required. How to obtain complete remission of all sin on Divine Mercy Sunday:

- 1) Go to Confession before or on Divine Mercy weekend
- 2) Receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy week-
