ASH WEDNESDAY is this Wednesday, February 17th. The Mass schedule is Wednesday 7:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. at St. Francis.

LENTEN REGULATIONS: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of obligatory fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meatless meal, as well as two smaller meatless meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Abstinence from meat is binding upon Catholics from age 14 onwards. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be at St. Ambrose every Thursday immediately following 8:30 a.m. Mass and at St. Francis every Friday at 6:00 p.m.

THE WAY OF THE CROSS: The Altar Society purchased copies of the Magnificat, "*The Way of the Cross*" composed by Father Andrew Hofer. They will be available in the back of the church this weekend.

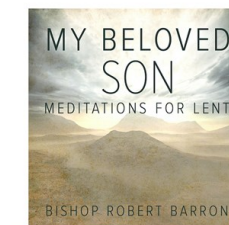
