It had been a long long time since we even made it to the big game, much less won. What an amazing feeling to experience that newness! My game-watching buddies and myself popped a bottle of champagne and enjoyed that night as if we were on top of the world...Only to recognize, the next day brought the same challenges the week before had brought.
