
PASTOR MUSINGS: I just signed up a group of our high school students to attend a Steubenville Youth Conference this summer in Springfield, MO. It is a weekend conference that is intended to help high school age youth encounter Jesus Christ, particularly in the sacraments, but also through the witness of each other seeking to live a life for Christ. It is very exciting to be sending a group there! I haven't been to a Steubenville since I was a deacon at Our Lady of Guadalupe in South Hutchinson. I went with the youth group at that parish back in 2017. While I was assigned at St. Isidore's at K-State, I attended every year a much larger Catholic conference called SEEK, put on by the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS) over the Christmas break. In fact, a few college students from St. Paul attended SEEK this year with St. Pius X Newman Center. At SEEK, there are somewhere between 15-20,000 college students gathered, celebrating Mass every day together, venturing around the 100s of booths to check out Catholic merch and various mission organizations and religious orders, and encountering other experiences of the Catholic faith. I find each of these Catholic experiences incredibly enlivening! It gives a boost to my faith that everyday living simply has no power to provide. We live in an age where these are available for adults as well, and regularly. Do not neglect every single opportunity and then wonder why you're never very inspired by Mass!!
