**STEWARDSHIP OUR GIFTS: WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING?** Today's gospel retells the calling of the first missionary disciples. Near the Sea of Galilee, Jesus sees Peter, Andrew, James, and John. These men know that fishing requires patience, perseverance, courage, and creativity; therefore, as fishers of men, they cannot expect instant results. They cannot give up easily.
