**STEWARDSHIP OUR GIFTS: WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING?** In today's first reading, Moses explains that discipleship and obedience to God's commandments are the most natural behaviors for us — "it is already in your mouths and in your hearts; you only have to carry it out." In the gospel, Jesus uses a parable to drive this point home when he is questioned by "a scholar of the law." The young scholar clearly understands the law as it is written, but questions Jesus on who, exactly, his neighbor is. After listening to the parable, the scholar has no problem understanding that a neighborly person is one who shows love. In fact, the answer was already in his heart, he simply needs to carry it out, as Moses said! This week, reflect on the reading from Deuteronomy. Discipleship is not too mysterious and remote for you. It is not out of reach, up in the sky or across the sea. It is already in your heart, and has been since your baptism. You only have to carry it out.
