STEWARDSHIP OUR GIFTS: WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING? Jesus appointed seventy-two “others” (aside from the Twelve) to go ahead of Him to the places he intended to visit, for the “harvest is abundant but the laborers are few...” Who are these “others” He has sent forth? Are they qualified to do this work?? Of course they are!! Like you and I, they are missionary disciples, commissioned to take part in Jesus’ ministry. It doesn’t require special training — it simply requires having faith that God will give us what we need in order to complete the work. Notice Jesus tells the seventy-two to “carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals.” Instead, they (and we!) are to rely on God to lead and provide.
