THE MONTH OF JUNE IS DEDICATED TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS.

The meaning: Based on her visions, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque designed and produced the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In the image, we see the heart outside the chest of Jesus, shining with divine light. It has wounds and bleeding, encircled by the crown of thorns, and with a cross on the top. The wounded hands of Jesus point to the heart.

The Heart stands for the physical heart of Jesus and His sacrificial love for humanity.

The pierced and bleeding heart reminds us of the piercing of His heart while He was on the cross and the last drop of blood and water that came out of His sacrifice.

The crown of thorns is the symbol of the crown of sharp thorns placed on the head of Jesus to humiliate Him and torture Him before His crucifixion.

The cross on the top of the heart is standing for the cross Jesus used to win victory for humanity. It is the ladder that connects heaven and earth through the redemptive work of Jesus.

Flames on the heart is symbolic of the burning flame of love of Jesus for humanity.

The light surrounding the heart is standing for the divine light that shines in the darkness of this world.

ADORATION: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be at St. Francis on Wednesdays from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and at St. Ambrose on Thursdays from the close of 8:30 a.m. Mass until 1:00 p.m. To volunteer for Adoration, please call Jackie Harmon at the Rectory (620-449-2224) or one of the following: for St. Francis, Jane Anne Beachner (620-449-2751) for St. Ambrose, Donna Bohrer (620-244-3709 or 620-423-1562). 
