KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS BENEFIT BREAKFAST:



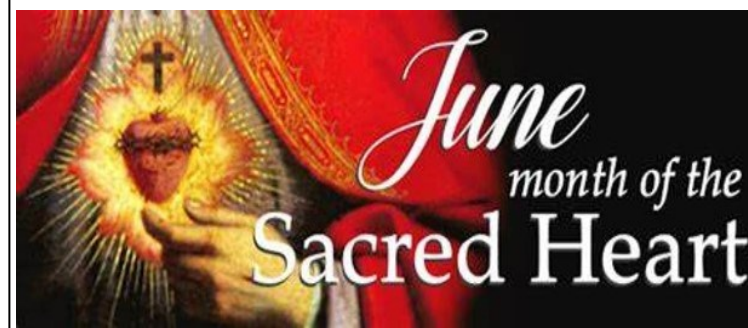
