STEWARDSHIP OUR GIFTS: WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING? You have heard that being a steward is a way of life. In other words, it is not *what* we do -- it is *who* we are. In the word stewardship is implied a level of servant hood; there is a willingness to serve God and others. Today's readings mention a few of the Biblical figures who were unlikely servants, raised up by God: Israel (Jacob), David, and John the Baptist. We, too, were called into servant hood while in the womb. We were created to be good stewards of our lives and we should rejoice in it! Like John the Baptist, we live as servants of God, allowing our very existence to proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord of our lives.
