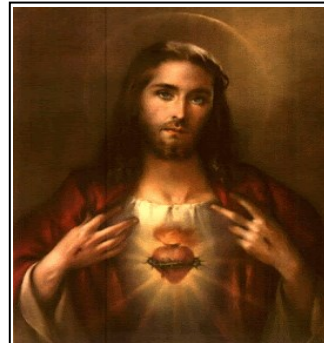

The Life of Blessed Carlo Acutis:  
The Eucharist - My Highway to Heaven

Young Italian Carlo Acutis believed if people understood the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist, and the amazing graces that they could receive from it, their lives would be transformed. Driven by his desire to share this understanding and using his skills in art and computers, Carlos began compiling information from all of the Eucharistic Miracles of the world, even traveling to many of the sites to photograph them, and created this exhibit. Carlo completed this work in 2005 and died a year later of leukemia at the young age of 15. He was beatified "Blessed" by Pope Francis October 10, 2020.
