CORPUS CHRISTI: The Catholic Church honors Christ's Presence in the Holy Eucharist with a special feast owing to St. Juliana of Liège, a 13th-century Norbertine canoness from Belgium. She had a great love for the Eucharist. When she was 16, she had a vision in which the Church was a full moon with a dark spot. The dark spot signified that the Church was missing a feast dedicated solely to the Body and Blood of Christ. Even though she had this vision several times, St. Juliana didn't think that she could do anything to help institute this feast. Therefore, she kept it a secret for many years. Once she was elected prioress, she finally told her confessor, who in turn told the bishop. This eventually led to the universal feast of Corpus Christi.

GENERAL DISPENSATION IS LIFTED: Bishop Kemme has lifted the general dispensation for laity of the Diocese of Wichita. "As Catholics, Sunday Mass is not only an obligation but a great privilege and should never be missed without good reason. The Church places such great emphasis on the Sunday celebration of the Mass as our spiritual nourishment that she obliges us to be present, unless we have a legitimate reason for being absent. We should all take to heart the Church's directives for us in this regard." *Bishop Carl Kemme*
