MASS AND FAST FOR IRELAND on May 25, 2018, the people of Ireland will vote to retain or repeal their eighth amendment, which guarantees life to both the mother and the baby. If repealed, Ireland will have abortion on demand."

Bishop Kemme said the priests of the United States have been asked by their pro-life brothers and sisters in Ireland to offer Masses and fast in anticipation of the referendum. To promote their efforts, Irish pro-lifers have initiated a "Mass and Fast for Ireland Campaign." Details are available at www.MassAndFastForIreland.com. Bishop Kemme is asking priests of the Diocese of Wichita, from now until May 25, "to offer at least one Mass for this intention and to invite your parishioners to lift up their hearts in prayer for the unborn of Ireland."
