PASTOR MUSINGS: I enjoyed this last week and a half having Fr. Richard Crager around. As most of you know, he grew up in St. Paul, and has plenty of family around, but is now a priest with a religious community called the Salesians, and is located in Tampa, FL. We were able to spend a lot of time together and chat about his upbringing and his love for his hometown. It was beautiful for me to hear as a new resident of this place. It truly is incredible the number of religious vocations that have been fostered over the years in this small Catholic area. There are 3 priests that are living who originated from St. Paul (4 if you count Fr. Schibi), and I don't know of any living sisters from here but there may be a handful. When I was at St. Isidore's at Kansas State, I initiated a project to put up a "vocations wall" in the lobby. It was simply a wall with pictures and very short bios of young men and women who were called and answered the call to give their lives to Christ as a priest, sister or brother. It turned out very nice – check it out if you're ever in Manhattan. I did this, because I believe one measure of a healthy parish is that young people are discerning the possibility of giving their lives in this way. It demonstrates healthy families, with Christ at the center. When other things our lives take first place, such as possibly sports, academics, career, hunting, etc, to give one's life to Christ becomes an impossible thought. Rest assured, I will be encouraging our children to consider this possibility in their lives. It's a life of joy and adventure in living for Jesus Christ. Thank God for Fr. Crager and the others who have given witness to this life.
