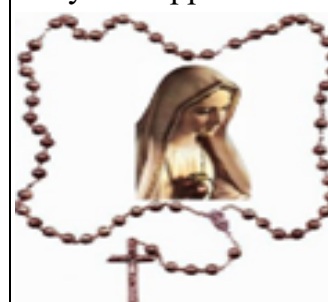
KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS will have a meeting today, Sunday, November 12th at 7:00 p.m. in the St. Francis Parish Hall.
