**STEWARDSHIP OUR GIFTS: WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING?** It is not unusual for Christian disciples to wonder about the “end times.” In today’s Gospel, Jesus speaks to the destruction of the temple, which would have signaled the end of time for the Jews of His day. Jesus knows this and tries (once again) to explain that there is no way to anticipate the day or the hour of the end of time. If we are *fully alive* in our discipleship, then we do not have time nor need to worry about when the end might arrive. Jesus says we are not to ponder these things, but have faith that the Holy Spirit will give us the wisdom we need when we need it. We have been called into a service that lasts until the very end... whenever that may be. Remain fully alive in your mission and allow the Spirit to empower you for the difficult days you will endure. Jesus promises that “not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives.”
