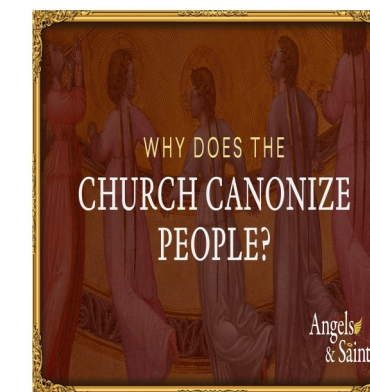

PASTOR MUSINGS: Thank God for this rain we've received recently! Happy to see the drought end. As we continue in this month of November, a month given over to praying for the dead in our Book of Remembrance, as well as recognizing the blessings of God in preparing spiritually for Thanksgiving, I want to talk on another matter of prayer. When I first arrived here in Saint Paul and saw our bulletin for the first time, I noticed something immediately: the list of names seeking prayers on the first inside page. This is called prayer of 'intercession', coming from the Latin word 'cedere' (to go) and 'inter' (between). It is prayer in which we 'go between' God and the person we pray for. Or we call upon another intercessor, such as a saint or the Blessed Virgin Mary, and have them 'go between' God and ourselves. This is an act of charity, to pray intercessions for others. A necessary act of charity! If we neglect to do so, we should confess that! While this is true, in speaking with my council and others around the parish, as well as my own experience, it seems we need a small reform to the intercession section of our bulletin. Many names remain on the list for a long time, and can cause the list to lose relevance, which we don't want. In looking for solutions to help our parish remain faithful in intercession, we want our list to be updated regularly. After consulting the council, we've decided to start a new list of parishioners looking for prayers the 1st of every month. Starting in December, if you or a close relative would like prayers from the parish faithful, please reach out to Jackie to be added to our bulletin. Please pray for me, as I pray for you.
