STEWARDSHIP OUR GIFTS: WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING? In today's Gospel, Jesus gives us the two great commandments -- First, you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. Second, you shall love your neighbor as yourself. These commandments not only encompass all 10 commandments given to Moses, they also encompass Stewardship, as we define it in our diocese. To be "fully alive as missionary disciples" requires us to recognize and receive God's gifts and to share those gifts in love of God and neighbor. Whether you proclaim God's word as a lector, hold a regular hour of Adoration, serve on a committee, volunteer in a classroom, or serve your elderly parents, visit a sick neighbor, or even participate in the election process as a citizen, you are practicing Stewardship. When you do these things out of love (rather than obligation), you are showing your dedication to God and your neighbor. The scribe in today's reading understood that love for God and neighbor is worth more than all the burnt offerings and sacrifices man could offer. Clearly love is key to discipleship.

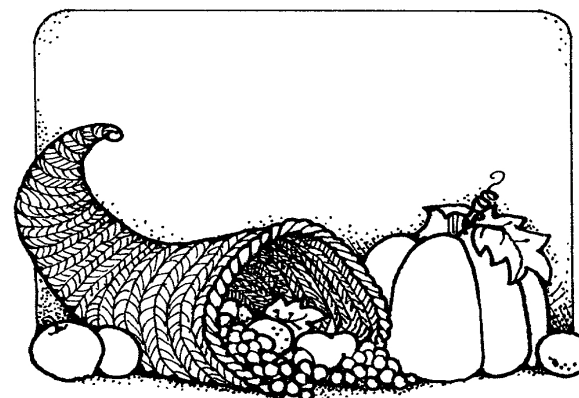
