**STEWARDSHIP OUR GIFTS: WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING?** How often do we turn to Jesus in prayer with a very specific request? "Please heal my mom." "Please help me get this job." "Please ease my suffering." We can look at the request of James and John in today's gospel and recognize the self-centered nature of their question. Jesus, rather than rebuking them, simply invites them into his suffering, and tells them that if they want honor they must become servants of all. Being fully alive as missionary disciples means that we, too, are willing to put our self-centered requests to the side. Instead, we can ask God to help us serve others (and HIM!) to the best of our ability. Then, our prayers might sound more like this: "Please give me the mind and heart to care for my mother through her death." "Please give this job to the person who needs it the most." "Please help me use this suffering to grow in love for you and others." Prayer is one of the pillars of stewardship, and is most certainly a way we can serve God and others!
