FORMED FOR MISSION EPISODE 20: AN APOSTOLIC SPIRITUALITY

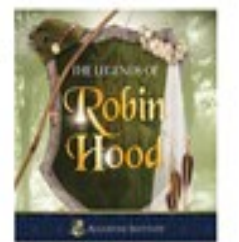
