STEWARDSHIP OUR GIFTS: WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING? The parable in today's gospel has many beautiful nuances, but here is one you may not have considered. At the end of the day, the landowner finds men standing around near his vineyard and asks, "Why do you stand here idle all day?... You too go into my vineyard." Of all the workers hired that day, this last group is the most controversial. It seems unfair that they were hired at the last minute and given the same pay as those who had worked all day. But look at the compassion with which they were treated. The landowner didn't want to see anyone go without work. He *empowered* them, much as our Heavenly Father empowers us. As missionary disciples, we must not stand idly by. We have work to accomplish! And whether you are young or old or somewhere in between, be prepared to be called to work! It is never too late to be given a task. Your discipleship does not end until you depart this life for the next.
