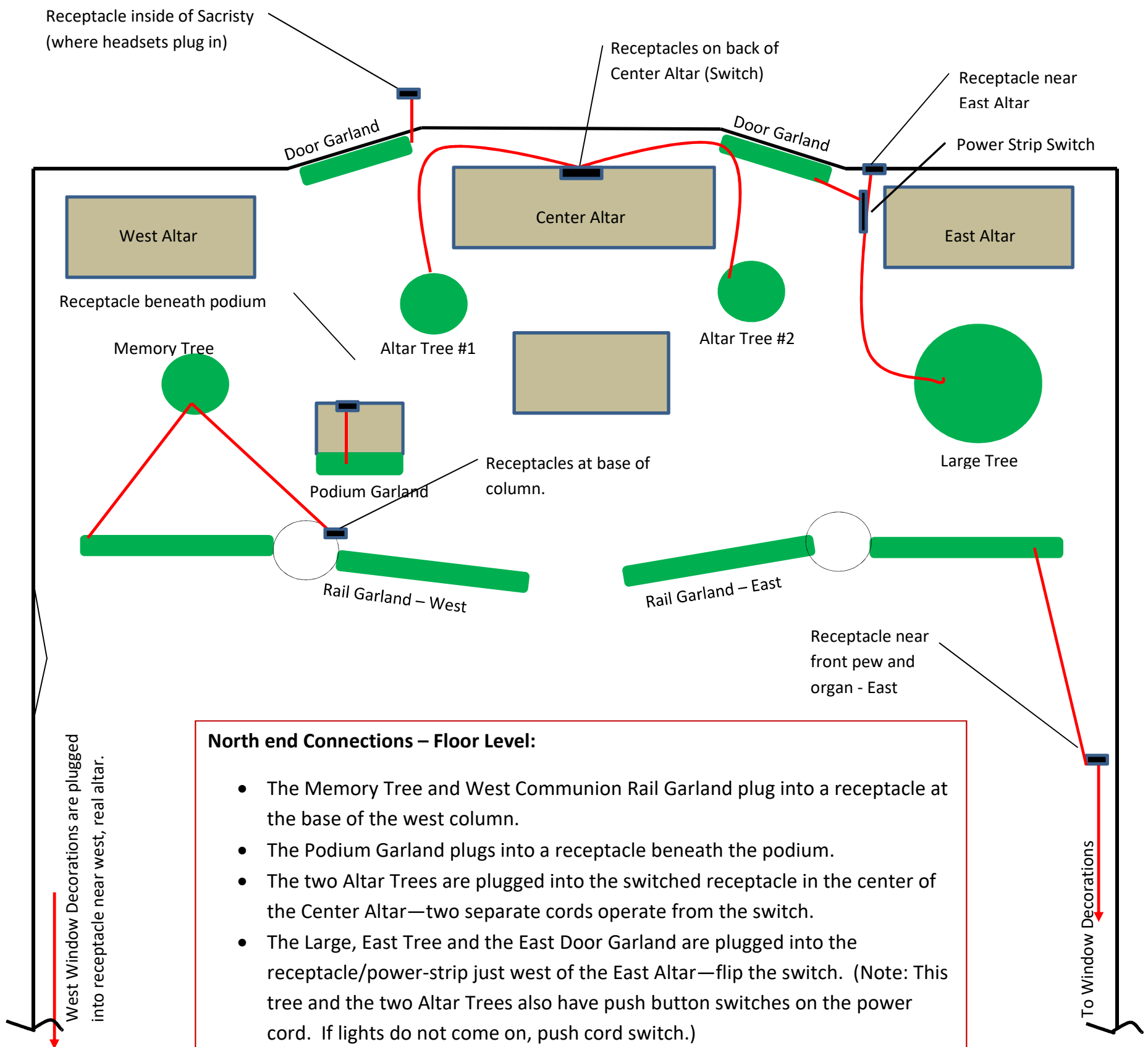


Christmas Decoration Connections—2016



North end Connections – Floor Level:

- The Memory Tree and West Communion Rail Garland plug into a receptacle at the base of the west column.
- The Podium Garland plugs into a receptacle beneath the podium.
- The two Altar Trees are plugged into the switched receptacle in the center of the Center Altar—two separate cords operate from the switch.
- The Large, East Tree and the East Door Garland are plugged into the receptacle/power-strip just west of the East Altar—flip the switch. (Note: This tree and the two Altar Trees also have push button switches on the power cord. If lights do not come on, push cord switch.)
- The West Door Garland plugs into the receptacle inside of the sacristy where the headset case plugs in.
- The East Communion Rail Garlands and the East Window Decorations are powered by the receptacles near the front pews (and organ)—near or on the heating ducts.
- The west Window decorations are plugged into a receptacle on the heating duct race near the west-rear altar.

North End – Upper Window Garlands:

- The garlands below the upper windows, at each side of the Center Altar, should be plugged in upstairs. Receptacles are located in the light switch plates just inside of the doors. The electrical cords are on the floor.

Choir Loft Garlands and Wreaths:

At the time this diagram was made the upstairs wiring was being worked on. But you can expect:

- A switched power strip near the west column that serves most of the west end of the balcony garlands and wreaths.
- A plug or power strip near the organ that serves the rest of the garlands and wreaths.
